

Holy Water is a sacramental: it reminds us of a sacrament without itself being one. Clearly holy water is a reminder of our baptism, a sacred and holy moment in our lives. To supply holy water from a plastic bucket at the back of the church seems less dignified than might be appropriate. As a reminder of baptism, holy water should be stored in the baptismal font, as it will be from now on therefore. Please go into the baptistery and collect holy water whenever you wish.
